AN ACT Relating to Vacation and Sick Leave of Certain Employees of
Highway Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

State Highway Department employees credit for vacation and sick leave when employed overtime. The State Personnel Board is directed to amend the Personnel Law and rules so that the classified employees in the following classifications: Highway Maintenancemen I, II, II₂, III and IV of the State Highway Department shall receive credit for vacation and sick leave for each hour employed after a 40-hour week.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is intended here to provide by statute and personnel rules and regulations that certain Highway Department employees working over 40 hours receive credit for such overtime toward vacation and sick leave.
