**AN ACT** Relating to the State Police Retirement System.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 25, § 1591, amended.** The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 1591 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

This section shall apply only to persons who were members of the State Police on July 9, 1943, **except that any such member who was employed in such a position on or before July 9, 1943 shall be retired upon attainment of age 55.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this Act to provide retirement at age 55 for those members of the State Police employed prior to July 9, 1943.
