AN ACT Prohibiting the Landing of Supersonic Transport Planes in Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 3965, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 3965 to read as follows:

§ 3965. Landing of supersonic transport planes

It is unlawful for any person to land at any airport in Maine a supersonic transport plane which creates noise at a level greater than 108 perceived noise, in decibels. Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or by both.
