AN ACT Relating to the Availability in Industries of On-site Medical
Facilities and Personnel.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 26, § 8, additional. Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 8 to read as follows:

§ 8. On-site medical facilities

The Commissioner of Labor and Industry shall promulgate rules and regulations, after hearing, regarding the availability of on-site medical facilities and personnel for all factories and workshops. Such rules and regulations shall be based on standards, including, but not limited to, the size of the factory or workshop, the risk involved in the employment by the industry, the distance of the work area from other medical services and the number of employees involved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the Commissioner of Labor and Industry to issue rules and regulations as to availability of on-site medical facilities for factories and workshops.
