STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Termination of Compensation under Workmen's Compensation Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 39, § 100, amended. Section 100 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 10 of chapter 408 of the public laws of 1965, and as amended by chapter 309 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding a new sentence at the end to read as follows:

If an employer terminates compensation, except as provided by this section, he shall be liable for double the weekly compensation from the date he ceased paying compensation until the date of the commission's order making a determination on petition for review of incapacity.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide compensation to be paid to employees when compensation terminated except as provided when there is a review of incapacity.
