COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1076, L. D. 1468, Bill,
"AN ACT Revising the Laws Relating to the Deposit of Oil,
Forest Products Refuse and Potatoes in Waters of the State."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§417." of section
2 by inserting at the end of the first underlined paragraph,
before the colon, the following: ', except as otherwise provided
by law'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§417." of
section 2 by inserting at the end the following:

'C. Refuse. Any scrap metal, junk, paper, garbage, septic
tank sludge, rubbish, old automobiles or similar refuse.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment expands the prohibitions of materials to include
refuse and defines this term.
