AN ACT Relating to Credits to Liquor Licensees by Wholesalers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 304, amended. Section 304 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 12 of chapter 360 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

This section shall not prohibit Maine state wholesale licensees from offering to Maine state liquor licensees normal credits and the usual and customary commercial credits in the purchases of malt and vinous liquors.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit licensees to receive credit for liquor purchases, the same as is received by wholesalers.
