STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Clarify the Classification of Certain Minor Tributaries of the Penobscot River.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., T. 38, § 368, amended. Subsection I of that part of section 368 relating to the Penobscot River, Minor Tributaries of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- I. All tributaries, direct and indirect, and segments thereof, of the Penobscot River from the confluence of the East and West Branches of the Penobscot, with the exception of the Piscataquis and Mattawamkeag Rivers Drainage Systems, to and including Pushaw Stream on the west shore of the Penobscot River and to and including Blackman Stream on the east shore of the Penobscot River, unless otherwise specified or classified—Class B-1.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The present wording of the amended section does not clearly indicate the classification of Pushaw and Blackman Streams. This bill is intended to clearly indicate that the classification of these streams is B-1.
