STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Interstate Highway No. 295.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 52-A, additional. Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 52-A, to read as follows:

§ 52-A. Obligations of Turnpike Authority

The State of Maine acting through the State Highway Commission shall assume all the responsibilities, powers and duties and discharge all obligations of the Maine Turnpike Authority in relation to that portion of the Maine Turnpike designated Interstate 95 and which said section of Maine Turnpike connects with the 2 ends of Interstate 295 and is designated as part of the Interstate Highway System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The State of Maine through the State Highway Commission is presently constructing a portion of the Interstate Highway System designated as Interstate 295.

Said construction may involve the duplication of facilities in that portion where said highway joins the Maine Turnpike.

It is in the best interests of the State of Maine to combine that section of the Maine Turnpike designated as Interstate 95 which connects with the two ends of Interstate 295.
