AN ACT Relating to Interstate Highways No. 95 and 295.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 52-A, additional. Section 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 52-A, to read as follows:

§ 52-A. Obligations of Turnpike Authority

The State of Maine acting through the State Highway Commission shall assume all the responsibilities, powers and duties and discharge all obligations of the Maine Turnpike Authority in relation to that portion of the Maine Turnpike designated as part of the Interstate Highway System.

STATEMENT OF FACT

A portion of the Maine Turnpike has been designated as a part of the Interstate Highway System. Certain portions of said Maine Turnpike is the only section of the Interstate Highway System in the State of Maine not under the supervision and control of the State Highway Commission.

Sound highway planning would be furthered by the control and supervision of the entire Interstate Highway System by the State Highway Commission.
