STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT to Repeal Provisions for Municipal Ordinances Relating to Shellfish and Marine Worms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4252, repealed. Section 4252 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by sections 5 to 8 of chapter 33 of the public laws of 1965, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to foster, encourage and assist the conservation, preservation and development of the shellfish industry by limited cultivation.
