HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1240, L. D. 1527, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Precautions at Railroad Crossings."

Amend said Bill in the 3rd, 4th and 5th lines (2nd, 3rd and 4th in L. D.) after the amending clause by striking out the underlined words "unless such team or vehicle shall first be stopped within a reasonable distance from the nearest rail of of such crossing, and" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'until'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to clarify the duty of the operator of a team or vehicle at a railroad crossing.
