STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officers of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 4, § 113, amended. Section 113 of Title 4 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 113. Messenger of Cumberland County

The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall be appointed by the senior resident Superior Court Justice and shall receive an annual salary of \$6,600 \$7,200 in full compensation for service and attendance.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 30, § 2, amended. The 4th paragraph of section 2 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Cumberland County: County commissioners, \$5,225; clerk of courts, \$8,800**\$9,600**; deputy clerk of courts, \$8,200 **\$9,000**; county attorney, \$10,000; first assistant county attorney, \$7,000; second assistant county attorney, \$7,000; third assistant county attorney, \$7,000; county treasurer, \$7,150 **\$9,000**; sheriff, \$8,800 **\$10,000**; register of deeds, \$8,250 **\$9,000**; deputy register of deeds, \$6,600 **\$7,200**; judge of probate, \$9,900 **\$10,800**; register of probate, \$7,700 **\$8,400**.

Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1971.
