SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1115, L. D. 1534, Bill,
"AN ACT Authorizing the Bureau of Public Improvements to Assist
Municipalities and School Administrative Districts in the
Construction of School Buildings."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 9 and
inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 9. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
Bureau of Public Improvements from the General Fund the sum
of \$14,000, to carry out the purposes of this Act. The
