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**AN ACT Relating to Fair Minimum Rate of Wages for Construction of  
Public Improvements by the State of Maine.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 26, § 1306, amended.** The 3rd sentence of section 1306 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 406 of the public laws of 1965 and as repealed and replaced by chapter 403 of the public laws of 1967, is amended to read as follows:

The "fair minimum rate of wages," for the intent and purposes of sections 1304 to 1313, shall be the prevailing wages paid in the locality in like construction, including fair minimum overtime, holiday pay, pensions, health and welfare benefits and all other benefits paid by employers on behalf of employees.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to more definitely define the minimum rate of wages in the construction of public improvements by the State of Maine.
