**AN ACT Prohibiting the Turning Back of Speedometers or Odometers on
Motor Vehicles.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 17, § 1609-A, additional. Title 17 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1609-A, to read as follows:

§ 1609-A. Turning back, tampering or disconnecting speedometers or odometers on motor vehicles

Any person who turns back, tampers with, disconnects or causes to turn back, tamper with or disconnect the speedometer or odometer of any motor vehicle with intent to deceive shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.
