Licenses for the sale of spirituous and vinous liquor and malt liquor to be consumed on the premises may be issued to operators of international air

terminals or their agent or concessionaire on payment of the fee as provided for a Class A restaurant.

Such license granted shall authorize the licensee to sell spirituous and vinous liquors and malt liquor to passengers of any airline, provided such passenger is in transit and whose point either of origin or destination is a foreign country.

Any license granted under this section shall not be subject to section 4, nor shall it be subject to the food requirements contained in section 2, subsection 18.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
