SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1132, L. D. 1560, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Property Tax Relief for the Elderly."

Amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$ 1102." by inserting after subsection 7 the following:

'7-A. Income classes and percentages. Property tax shall be waived on the following basis:

, <u>Income</u>	Amount waived
<u>\$ 0 - \$ 999</u>	100%
1,000 - 1,999	70%
2,000 - 2,999	40%
3,000 - 3,999	10%

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of those sections designated "§ 1103." and "§ 1105."

Further amend said Bill in section 1 by renumbering that part designated "§ 1104." to be '§ 1103.'

Further amend said Bill in section 3 in the 2nd line by striking out the figure "\$6,159,000" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$3,500,000'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to remove the provision for lien, waive property tax on a percentage basis as determined by amount of income and to carry out the recommendations of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.
