COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 525, L. D. 1565, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Probation of Juveniles in Cumberland County."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 5 the following:

'Sec. 6. Application and effective date. This Act shall become effective July 1, 1973, at which time all cases being processed by the Cumberland County Juvenile Probation Department shall be transferred to the State Probation and Parole Board and pending custody any person shall also be so transferred. Any employee presently employed by the Cumberland County Juvenile Probation Department shall have the opportunity of employment with the Division of Probation and Parole of the State of Maine Department of Mental Health and Corrections.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to have the Act effective July 1, 1973 at which time all cases shall be transferred to the State Probation and Parole Board and personnel will have opportunity of employment with the State Probation and Parole Board.
