SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1253, L.D. 1573, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to the Right of Access by Landlords."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined
paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'For the purposes of subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4, unless the
tenant agrees otherwise, such entry may be made only during
reasonable hours after reasonable advance notice to the tenant.
For the purpose of subsection 5 entry may be made without prior
notice to the tenant.'
