SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1256, L. D. 1576, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Fees for Inspection of Motor Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 3 the following: 'Sec. 4. R. S., T. 29, § 2124, amended. The 2nd sentence of the last paragraph of section 2124 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows: These shall be furnished by the office of the Chief of the State Police at 10e 30¢ each.'

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 4 and 5 to be 5 and 6.

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd line from the end by striking out the figure "\$1" and inserting in place thereof the following: '\$1 \$2'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to increase the inspection fee for motor vehicles from \$1 to \$2 and increase the price of the stickers to the inspection station from $10 \not\in$ to $30 \not\in$. The increase in the cost of the stickers will increase revenues about \$600,000 for the biennium.
