Amend said Bill in section A by inserting before the caption "SUPREME JUDICIAL AND SUPERIOR COURTS" the following:
'STATE EMPLOYEES' SUGGESTION AWARDS BOARD

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the last 3 lines of section A and inserting in place thereof the following:

'ALL APPROPRIATIONS \$182,949,815 \$188,618,612

Amounting to \$182,949,815 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1972 and \$188,618,612 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section C and by relettering sections D and E to be sections C and D.
