

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1252, L. D. 1578, Bill, "AN ACT to Indemnify Public Officials and Employees of the State of Maine."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the words "and Employees"

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in the 4th line after the amending clause (same in L. D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", officer or employee" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'or officer'

Further amend said Bill in the 6th line after the amending clause (5th and 6th lines in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "or any state employee"

Further amend said Bill in the 10th and 11th lines after the amending clause (10th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined punctuation and words ", officer or employee" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'or officer'

Further amend said Bill in the 14th line after the amending clause (13th line in L.D.) by striking out after the underlined word "official" the underlined words "or employee"

Further amend said Bill in the 14th and 15th lines after the amending clause (13th line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined

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punctuation and words ", director or employee" and inserting in place thereof the underlined words 'or director'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. Intent. It is not the intent of this Act to create a cause of action against the State or any of its subdivisions that did not exist heretofore nor is it intended to change the rules of law applicable to the determination of liability of a public official of the State.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendmnet is to eliminate state employees from the bill and to add a section to the bill stating the intent of the Act.
