## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATIVE

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1143, L. D. 1584, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a Food Stamp Program for Piscataquis County."

Amend said Bill in the Title by inserting after the word "County" the following words 'and Sagadahoc County'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Sagadahoc County; food stamp program. The State
Department of Health and Welfare is authorized to administer
a food stamp program in Sagadahoc County in conformity with
regulations promulgated by the United States Department of
Agriculture and the United States Department of Health, Education
and Welfare and is further authorized to hire the necessary
personnel to administer said program. The Department of Health
and Welfare shall be reimbursed by the County of Sagadahoc for
any administrative expenses incurred for carrying out this Act.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assist the welfare of many people in Sagadahoc County by providing a food stamp program.
