**AN ACT to Reimburse School Administrative District No. 54 for Additional
School Construction Costs.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to School Administrative District No. 54 the sum of \$67,100 for additional school construction costs because of failure of certain state agencies to review the building plans.

STATEMENT OF FACT

All school plans are supposed to be reviewed by the appropriate state agencies, before being approved for construction, and this was overlooked by several agencies in the case of School Administrative District No. 54.

The Department of Rehabilitation has sent letters that the new school building is in violation of the present state statutes. These agencies were supposed to review the plans and where it appears that this was not done, the State should pay the additional costs.
