HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1257, L. D. 1589, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Catering at Events and Gatherings."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

- 'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 28, §801-A, sub-§2, repealed and replaced.

 Subsection 2 of section 801-A of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes,
 as enacted by chapter 314 of the public laws of 1969, is repealed
 and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 2. Sponsor. The license provided for by this section shall authorize the licensee to sell liquor only at public events or public gatherings sponsored by a charitable, nonprofit organization or civic groups and private events or private gatherings sponsored by an individual person, organization or association of persons.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to permit nonprofit charitable organizations to hold catered public functions.
