COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 481, L. D. 1593, Bill,  
"AN ACT Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport Authority."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of the last 2 sentences of the 2nd paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The Authority is authorized to extend its runways and related facilities over or across the public highways of the City of Auburn where alternative means of access are or can be made available to persons served by the highway and where such construction would not unduly interfere with some other existing public purpose of the city, except that any alteration of state or state aid highways shall only be accomplished with the approval of the State Highway Commission. The Authority shall assume responsibility for all costs of such work including the cost of providing alternative roads or access ways where such is required and shall indemnify the city or the State Highway Commission, based upon the jurisdictional classification of the highway facility, for any liability which it may incur to 3rd persons as a result of such construction including damages for negligent performance of the work.'

Further amend said Bill in section 11 by adding at the end of the 2nd paragraph the following sentence:

'The 5th member shall be selected by the 4 board members so appointed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for the approval by the State Highway Commission before any alteration is made affecting highways and to provide for the appointment of the 5th member, the 5th member having been inadvertently left out.
