HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to S. P. 481, L. D. 1593, Bill,  
"AN ACT Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport Authority."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 14 the following:

'Sec. 15. Referendum. This Act shall take effect 90 days after the adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn at their respective municipal elections in 1972.

The result of the vote in said Cities of Lewiston and Auburn shall be declared by the appropriate officials of the respective cities and due certificates thereof shall be forthwith filed by the respective city clerks with the Secretary of State and if the result so filed shows that a majority of the legal voters of the City of Lewiston voting at said election and a majority of the legal voters of the City of Auburn voting at said election approve this Act, the city clerks shall forthwith certify the same to be so by causing the filing of a certificate with the Secretary of State.

Upon such approval by both the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn, all the provisions of this Act shall thereupon take effect.

Upon the failure of either of the Cities of Lewiston and Auburn to approve this Act, it shall become null and void.

• The respective city clerks shall prepare the required ballots on which they shall reduce the subject matter of this Act to the following question: "Shall the Act Establishing the Lewiston-Auburn Airport Authority, passed by the 105th Legislature, be

accepted?" The voters shall indicate their opinion of the same by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No".
