HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1151, L. D. 1602, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Motor Vehicle Operator's License for Speeding Violation."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first and 2nd underlined paragraphs of that part designated "<u>52241-A.</u>" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Any person committing a 2nd speeding violation of 10 miles per hour or more over the posted speed limit under this Title within a period of one year shall have his license and privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this State suspended for 30 days upon conviction.

Any person committing a 3rd speeding violation of 10 miles per hour or more over the posted speed limit within a period cf one year shall have his license and privilege to operate a motor vehicle in this State suspended for 60 days upon conviction.'

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd underlined paragraph of that part designated "<u>§2241-A.</u>" by striking out in the first line the underlined words "convicted of" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word 'committing': and by inserting after the underlined word "indefinitely" in the 3rd line (2nd and 3rd lines of L. D.) the underlined words 'upon conviction'
