HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 538, L. D. 1615, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Chiropractic Treatment under Workmen's Compensation
Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the first underlined
sentence after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'An employee sustaining a personal injury by accident arising
out of and in the course of his employment, provided said injury
consists of a lumbar, sacral or cervical strain diagnosed as
such by a member of said panel shall be entitled to reasonable
chiropractic treatment for the relief thereof.'

Statement of Fact

The amendment would assure the injured workman that his
injury was of a type which a chiropractor could treat under the
Workmen's Compensation Law.
