COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1210, L. D. 1657, Bill,
"AN ACT to Authorize Food Stamp Program."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the following underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the following:

'Sec. 2. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature that no state funds be appropriated or used in the state-wide food stamp program, but the Legislature feels that the Department of Health and Welfare should have authorization to administer such a program if paid for by the Federal Government or by counties or communities in the State. It is also the intent of the Legislature that the food stamp program in Androscoggin County shall continue as a pilot program until June 30, 1972, as far as state funds are concerned. The program may be continued by the county or by federal funding.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is reflected in section 2 of the bill on intent.
