Amend said Amendment by striking out in the 4th line the
underlined figure "\$3" and inserting in place thereof the figure
'\$2'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Further amend said Bill in section 2 in the 2nd line (same in
L.D.) by striking out the figure "\$47,140" and inserting in place
thereof the figure '\$31,690'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out all of
the last 4 lines before the Emergency clause and inserting in place
thereof the following:

'Personal Services	(1)	\$13,022	(1)	\$13,768
All Other		2,100		2,100
Capital Expenditures		700		-----
		<u>\$15,822</u>		<u>\$15,868'</u>


Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Set the maximum fee of \$2 for examination of private water supplies.
2. Change the appropriation to approximately \$16,000 per year and it is estimated that the bill will produce revenue from fees in the amount of \$16,000 per year.
