HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1273, L. D. 1674, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide an Implied Warranty and Covenant of Habitability
in Leases of Dwellings."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 11th and 12th lines
after the amending clause (9th and 10th in L.D.) the underlined
words and punctuation "Consequential damages may not be awarded
for the breach of the warranty of habitability."
