HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1286, L. D. 1685, Bill,
"AN ACT to Permit Camp Counselors to Supervise Canoeing."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 8th line after
the amending clause in section 1 (7th line in L.D.) the words
"who ~~is-a-holder~~ are holders" and inserting in place thereof
the words '~~who-is~~ and one counselor must be a holder'
