HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1287, L. D. 1686, Bill, "AN ACT
Establishing an Open Season on Moose."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the last 3 lines of the
4th paragraph of that part designated "§2355-D." the underlined
words and punctuation "Oakfield; then northerly along the B & A
Railroad to Squa Pan Junction, to Mapleton, to Washburn, to New
Sweden and thence to Van Buren." and inserting in place thereof
the following 'the Canadian border at Houlton.'
