SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1287, L. D. 1686, Bill, "AN ACT Establishing an Open Season on Moose."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2355-D." by striking out all of the 3rd underlined paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'For 1971, October 18th to October 23rd; for 1972, September 25th to September 30th.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2355-D." by striking out all of the last underlined sentence of the 5th paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'The fee for such application shall be \$1 which shall not be refunded.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2355-D." in the 8th paragraph by inserting after the first underlined sentence the following underlined sentence:

'The commissioner is authorized to divide the designated area open to moose hunting into zones and to designate the number of permits to be issued for each zone, not to exceed 500 in the entire area.'

1. Change the dates.
2. Establish a fee for the permits.
3. Establish hunting zones.
