STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for a Feasibility Study for Future Highway Improvements in the U. S. Route 1 Corridor from Warren to Belfast.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Feasibility study. The State Highway Commission shall make a feasibility study of the need and cost of improving by construction, reconstruction or relocation of that portion of U. S. Route I beginning in the vicinity of the intersection of U. S. Route I and State Route 90 in the Town of Warren and extending to the City of Belfast and shall report the results of the study to the next regular session of the Legislature.
