STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Winter Maintenance of State Aid Highways and Town Ways by Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1005, sub-§ 1, ¶¶ A, B and C, amended. Paragraphs A, B and C of subsection 1 of section 1005 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 490 of the public laws of 1969, are amended to read as follows:

A. If the state valuation exceeds \$750,000 \$1,000,000 reimbursements will be made to the extent of \$100 per mile in accordance with approved certification of costs.

B. If the state valuation is \$500,000 \$750,000 or less, such municipalities shall bear the first \$70 of cost per mile, and reimbursements shall be made to said municipalities in accordance with payrolls as submitted and approved; except that such reimbursement shall not exceed \$400 per mile.

C. If the state valuation is more than \$500,000 \$750,000 but does not exceed \$750,000 \$1,000,000, the municipalities shall bear the first \$70 of cost per mile, and reimbursements shall be made to said municipalities in accordance with payrolls as submitted and approved; except that such reimbursement shall not exceed \$300 per mile.
