HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 561, L. D. 1701, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Voters Resigning or Removed from the Voting List."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 7. R. S., T. 21, § 1579, sub-§ 13-A, additional.

Section 1579 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended,
is further amended by adding a new subsection 13-A to read
as follows:

13-A. Inducing person to vote by absentee ballot. A
person who induces a voter to vote by absentee ballot knowing
such person will be able to vote in person at the proper voting
place on election day;'

This amendment creates a misdemeanor when a person acts as
stated in the amendment.
