HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 561, L. D. 1701, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Voters Resigning or Removed from the Voting List."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end the following:

'Sec. 7. R. S., T. 21, § 1579, sub-§ 13-A, additional.

Section 1579 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 13-A to read as follows:

person who induces a voter to vote by absentee ballot. A person who induces a voter to vote by absentee ballot knowing such person will be able to vote in person at the proper voting place on election day;

This amendment creates a misdemeanor when a person acts as stated in the amendment.
