SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1315, L.D. 1723, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Protection of the Environment."


Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1261." by striking out all of the 2nd underlined sentence and inserting in place thereof the following underlined sentence:

'As a condition precedent to the maintenance of such action, any moving party, except the Attorney General, shall submit an affidavit, under penalty of perjury, setting forth facts establishing the violation of such law or regulation or ordinance, with a written demand upon the state or municipal agency having responsibility to enforce such law, regulation or ordinance.'
