HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1323, L. D. 1735, Bill,  
"AN ACT Relating to Distribution of Certain Taxes to Munici-  
palities."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 656-A."  
by striking out all of the first underlined sentence and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'The municipalities, upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory  
to the Commissioner of Finance and Administration, shall have a  
valid claim against the State to recover 100% of the taxes lost  
by reason of any exemptions from taxes otherwise assessed  
pursuant to Title 36, part 2, other than those statutory exemp-  
tions from such taxes as are in existence prior to the effective  
date of this section.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify what statutory  
exemptions are intended to be included.
