HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1324, L. D. 1736, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Termination of Human Pregnancy by Medical
Decision."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 51." of section 1
by inserting after subsection 1 the following subsection:

'1-A. Residency. Any woman requesting an abortion in the
State of Maine shall have resided in Maine for a period of at
least 90 days prior to such request.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a
residency requirement of at least 90 days in Maine for a woman
who requests an abortion.
