SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to S. P. 585, L. D. 1738, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to the Sale and Use of Lead Paint."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part
designated "§ 2404." and inserting in place thereof the
following:


'§ 2404. Chapter not intended to preempt local action

' Sections 2401 to 2403 shall not be applicable to dwellings
in any municipality having a total population of less than
10,000 and such sections shall not apply to dwellings in any
municipality having a total population of more than 10,000
upon enactment by such municipality of ordinances having the
same or greater restrictions than this chapter.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make the bill apply
only to municipalities having a population of 10,000 or more.
