SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1328, L. D. 1742, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Closed Season and Minimum Size of Coho Salmon."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of subsection 1 of
that part designated "§3951-A." and inserting in place thereof
the following:

'1. Exception for rod and line. It is lawful to fish for and
take coho salmon by rod and single line or by use of a spear but not
in any other manner. Spear fishing for coho salmon shall be
limited to the hours between sunrise and sunset.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to provide for coho salmon
in the same manner already provided for striped or sea bass in
section 4209.
