SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1341, L. D. 1760, Bill,
 "AN ACT to Appropriate in the Amount of \$1,440,000 for Parking
 Garage Facility for the Capitol Complex at Augusta."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first
 line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and
 figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the
 Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Fees. The Bureau of Public Improvements shall
 establish and charge user fees for patrons of the parking garage
 facility, when constructed, to provide assistance for operating and
 maintaining the same, if considered feasible and with the approval
 of the Governor and the Executive Council.

The Bureau of Public Improvements shall establish and charge
 user fees for any or all parking facilities within the legally
 designated capitol complex, if considered feasible and with the
 approval of the Governor and the Executive Council.

All user fees shall be credited to the General Fund.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to authorize the establishment
 of user fees to assist in the operation and maintenance of parking
 facilities within the capitol complex in Augusta.
