## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 105TH LEGISLATURE

HOUSE AMENDMENT " C" to H. P. 1345, L. D. 1764, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate Industrialized Housing under the Maine State Housing Authority."

Amend said Bill in that part designated " § 4774."

by striking out in the 5th line (same in L.D.) the underlined word and punctuation "laws,"; and by striking out in the 6th line (5th line of L.D.) the underlined words "the State and"

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4774." by striking out in the 7th line (6th line in L.D.) the underlined words "the approval" and inserting in place thereof the underlined word and figures 'section 4775'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4774." by striking out all of the 3rd underlined sentence.

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 4774." by striking out in the 2nd line of the last paragraph (same in L.D.) the underlined word and punctuation "laws,"; and by striking out in the last line (same in L.D.) the underlined words "by the State and"

## Statement of Fact

As drafted, the bill would give the State Housing Authority complete power to override any existing state laws as well as municipal ordinances. This amendment would restrict the Housing Authority's power to override existing state laws and confine it to ordinances and regulations enacted by local governments, the area which has posed the greatest obstacle to industrialized housing.
