SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1352, L.D. 1768, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Powers and Duties of the Environmental Improvement Commission."

Amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 13th line (11th line in L.D.) the striken out words "except-purely sterm-water-systems" and inserting in place thereof the following words 'except purely storm water systems located in or on or draining from public ways'

Further amend said Bill in section 2 by striking out in the 5th line from the end (4th from end in L.D.) the striken out words "except-purely-storm-water-systems" and inserting in place thereof the following words 'except purely storm water systems located in or on or draining from public ways'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt storm water systems in public ways from E.I.C. review, but at the same time to allow E.I.C. review of storm water systems that may be contaminated.
