SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to H. P. 1354, L. D. 1770, Bill, "AN ACT Regulating Roadside Clear Cutting Practices."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (same in L. D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, § 656, sub-§ 1, ¶ D-1, additional.  
Subsection 1 of section 656 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new paragraph D-1 to read as follows:

D-1. Any land which has been selectively  
cleared of trees under Title 12, section 519.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to exempt the land selectively cleared of trees under the bill from real estate taxation.
