HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1361, L.D. 1776, RESOLVE, Providing Minimum Retirement Benefits for Certain Teachers.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines from the end (same in L.D.) the words and punctuation "; and be it further" and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Mrs. Leslie Stillwell, Hodgdon, Maine
Christine Delano, Verona, Maine; and be it further'

Further amend said Resolve in the 4th and 5th lines from the end (4th from end in L.D.) by striking out in two places the figure "\$27,840" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$29,760'

The purpose of this amendment is to add Mrs. Delano, who is 75 years of age, and Mrs. Stillwell, who is 83 years of age, to the list.
